6.a [Consideration to Award Promote Astoria Properties Landscaping Contract](#)

Due to staffing and operational constraints within the Parks and Recreation Department, several City-owned and tourist-oriented properties are unable to consistently receive the level of landscaping attention desired through in-house maintenance operations alone. Many of these sites are highly visible public spaces and gateway corridors that are heavily utilized by both residents and visitors to Astoria.

Since 2016, the City Council has designated funding to support contracted landscape maintenance services at tourist-related properties throughout the community. The use of contracted services has allowed these sites to be

maintained at a higher standard of care and has enhanced the overall appearance of prominent public spaces throughout the city.

The Parks and Recreation Department recently solicited bids from qualified landscaping contractors for landscape maintenance services for Fiscal Year 2026-27. After review of submitted bids, staff recommend awarding the contract to Greensmith Landscapes in the amount of \$64,790.10.

7.a Public Hearing and First Reading of an Ordinance Amending the Astoria Camping Code

The Astoria City Council will hold a public hearing and consider a first reading of an ordinance to amend the Astoria Camping Code.

7.b Consideration of Resolution to Update Fees for Ocean View Cemetery - Fee Schedule F3

This update to the City's fee resolution pertains to the service-related charges at Ocean View Cemetery.

7.c Consideration of Resolution to apply for Local Government Grant from Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for improvements at Evergreen Fields

Staff have identified a potential funding source to carry out improvements at Evergreen Fields and are seeking Council's authorization to apply. The total grant amount requested is \$51,000, which would require a 40% match of \$34,000. The proposed improvements: restoring grass playing fields, adding another playable infield, rehabilitating the existing restroom building, installing a play area and picnic shelter, and upgrading accessibility by resurfacing asphalt paths align with public feedback provided during the Parks Master Plan Update.

7.d Discussion on Potential Amendments to the Astoria City Charter

The Astoria City Council will review potential draft language to the Astoria City Charter, and consider placement on a ballot for the upcoming general election.
