7.g [Lease Agreement with Columbia Memorial Hospital for Use of East Portion of Heritage Square Located at 1153 Duane Street and Closure of 12th Street between Duane and Exchange Streets](#)

Columbia Memorial Hospital, on behalf of the Astoria Regatta Association, is requesting the use of the east portion of Heritage Square located at 1153 Duane Street, and the closure of 12th Street between Duane and Exchange Streets to accommodate Astoria Regatta events. The time frame for the lease would be for Saturday, August 8, 2026, from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Events include food, beverages, information booths, children's events, and live music. It is requested that the Heritage Square site be leased for \$1.00. The Regatta activities provide an opportunity to bring an event to our community that continues to grow in popularity every year.

7.h [Approval of the Oregon Department of Emergency Management Homeland Security Grant Agreement](#)

The purpose of State Homeland Security Program is to assist states, tribes, local, and county governments to prevent, respond to, prepare for, and respond to acts of terrorism. Some of the security cameras located on the public safety building were identified as being at the end of life and we determined that we did not have full security camera coverage. Astoria Fire Station 2 has no security cameras. This grant will provide the funding needed to replace end of life cameras and install new security cameras to ensure full coverage. Staff recommends that Council approves of and authorizes the acceptance of the not to exceed \$25,000 Oregon Department of Emergency Management Homeland Security Grant and authorizes the appropriate signatures.

8. REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

8.a Second Reading and Adoption of an Ordinance Allowing for Transportation Network Companies to Operate within the Astoria City Limits

The Astoria City Council will consider holding a second reading and adoption of the ordinance to allow for transportation network companies to operate within the Astoria city limits.

8.b Authorization to Award the 2026 Paving Project Construction Contract

City Staff was previously authorized to solicit bids for the 2026 Paving Project and received two competitive bids to perform asphalt overlay paving and associated street maintenance activities on the streets identified below. Staff is recommending approval of a construction contract with Big River Construction, who provided the lowest responsible bid, for \$689,317.00 and to authorize a 15% (\$103,397.55) construction contingency.

8.d Authorization to Purchase Work Order and Asset Management Software

Staff is requesting City Council approval of an agreement with NOVOTX for the purchase and implementation of the ELEMENTS XS asset management system. The software will replace the City's current asset management system with a platform designed specifically for Public Works Operations, improving the management of infrastructure assets, work orders, inventory, and GIS integration. The total first-year cost is \$78,500 and is included in the FY 2026–2027 Public Works Improvement Fund Budget.

8.e Authorization to Award a Construction Contract for the 6th Street & Marine Drive Emergency Sanitary Sewer Repair Project

City staff identified a partially collapsed sanitary sewer pipe at the northeast corner of 6th Street and Marine Drive that requires repair before ODOT's upcoming ADA Ramp Project begins this fall. Staff recommends awarding a \$62,910 construction contract to Big River Construction and authorizing a 15% contingency of \$9,436.50 to complete the emergency repair by the end of August.
