2.a Public Hearing and Special use Permit Review Application: 185 Genesee St. to renovate a large house, previously used as a dental office, into three apartments on the first floor and one apartment on the basement level for four new dwellings.. 3.a Site Plan Review for demolition of a single-family dwelling and construction of a proposed 1,227 sq ft Sonic Restaurant, parking lot and associated storm water management facilities.
