Stats. section 19.85(1)(e) for the purpose of deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session and section 19.85(1)(g), Wis. Stats., for the purpose of conferring with legal counsel for the governmental body who is

rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved, namely to (1) consider an intergovernmental agreement between the City of Beloit and Rock County for the provision of temporary law enforcement services, (2) discuss the Notice of Injury filed by Christopher C Myers against the City of Beloit Police Department and two Beloit police officers; and (3) discuss federal lawsuit captioned Jeff Fitzgerald v. Interim Chief Thomas Stigler and the City of Beloit, et al.. The council may reconvene into open session to take action on the matter(s) discussed in closed session.
