VII. CONSENT AGENDA

- VII.1 Consideration of a Motion to approve a Resolution modifying the map which outlines the response districts for the provision of fire services within the Automatic Aid Agreement, which was entered into between the City of Winder and Barrow County, and for other purposes.
- VII.2 Consideration of a Motion to authorize issuing a Purchase Order (PO) in the amount of \$47,950.00 to Harrison & Harrison to install 4,300 linear feet of 2" Gas Main (3,900 linear feet will be by trench, and 400 feet will be by directional bore). This also includes 3 2x2 tie-ins to our Main in Heartland Subdivision, Phase 5. This is an FY2027 budgeted Capital expenditure known as CP# 202295, Gas 530-4700-542100.
