3. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION. Commission General Regulations – Workshop

A*. Commission General Regulation 527 – Wildlife Salvage Permit – Game Warden Captain Jake Kreamer

The Commission will hold a workshop to consider a regulation amending Chapter 501 of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) to create a salvage process and salvage permits for certain wildlife species through the direction of Senate Bill 215 (2025).

B*. Commission General Regulation 531 – Shed Antler Revisions – Chief Game Warden Kristy Knight

The Commission will hold a workshop to consider regulation language amending Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) that adds requirements for private land collecting, prohibiting nonresidents from collecting shed antlers until July 1, and creating definitions.

A*. Commission General Regulation 529 – Disability Permit Program Revisions – Data and Technology Services Division Administrator Matt Maples

The Commission will consider adopting regulation language amending Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) that would update business rules and requirements related to the archery, visual and special assistance disability permits.

B*. Commission General Regulation 532 – Windermere Hills Cooperative Wildlife Management Area – Habitat Division Administrator Mark Freese

The Commission will consider adopting language regulation by amending Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) that would update business rules and requirements related to the Windermere Hills Cooperative Wildlife Management Area.
