- **Courtesy Livestream, Video, and Minutes:** The meeting will be streamed live, with the recorded video thereafter available, at www.kauai.gov/Government/Council/Webcast-Meetings. If the courtesy broadcast connection cannot be maintained or is otherwise unavailable, the meeting will proceed. Meeting minutes will be completed pursuant to Hawai'i Revised Statutes Chapter 92 and electronically posted on the Council's website at www.kauai.gov/government/council following Council approval.
