EVENT DESCRIPTION - The forum will begin with opening remarks from Mayor Noble and Kingston Police Department Chief Egidio Tinti. Attendees will then have the opportunity to visit different stations where they can ask questions and speak to officers and Police Commissioners on a variety of topics. Confirmed stations include:

- *Introduction to the Police Commission*
 - o *What is the role of the Police Commission?*
 - o *How are individuals appointed?*
 - o *Are there other Commission and Advisory Board models to consider?*
- *Body Worn Cameras and Recording Devices*
 - o *How many cameras have been activated? How do they work? Do all officers wear these?*
 - o *Draft policy to be considered by Police Commission*
- *Right to Know Act- Officer Identification policy to be considered by Police Commission*
- *Community-Oriented Policing "COP" Car*
 - o *What events and areas should the officers visit or visit more frequently to build relationships in the community?*
- *Welcoming and Inclusive Community Resolution*
 - o *Is Kingston a sanctuary city?*
 - o *Attorney General Guidance and draft policy to be considered by Police Commission*
- *Police Training*
 - o *A comprehensive listing of required trainings*
 - o *What additional trainings should officers attend?*
- *Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design*
