6. OLD BUSINESS

6.1 Request to Evaluate Additional Traffic Safety Measures nearby 484 Nyes Place

The Committee considered a request to (1) trim the overgrown vegetation to restore the visibility of the existing roadside signs (specifically, the stop sign and chevron signs), (2) evaluate the street bend at this location for additional traffic safety measures, (3) evaluate the appropriateness of a “red-light” flashing beacon on the existing stop sign; and (4) implement additional pavement markings or reflective striping around the stop sign adjacent to 484 Nyes Place. On May 28, 2026, the Committee initiated the noticing process to establish red curb at the stop location extending southerly on Nyes Place for approximately 20-feet.

7. NEW BUSINESS

7.1 Request to Relocate Loma Terrace No Parking Sign

The Committee will consider a request to relocate the existing "No Parking" sign on the east side of Loma Terrace, currently located adjacent to 328 Loma Terrace, to a location approximately 165 feet north of the intersection of Loma Terrace and Y Place, adjacent to 308 Loma Terrace. The proposed relocation is intended to align the parking restriction signage with City-approved public parking spaces established in conjunction with the residential development projects along Loma Terrace.

The Committee will consider a request to install additional parking restrictions on Fairview Street to discourage vehicles blocking the residential driveways, improve turning movements at intersections for trash collection services and emergency vehicles, and improve visibility.
