A. [An Ordinance Amending Chapter 4 of the Northbrook Municipal Code \(1998\), as Amended, to Add a New Liquor License Class for Self-Service](#)

Establishments

The Ordinance Amendment will create a new Class R Liquor License for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor at self-service establishments, at which customers may serve themselves alcoholic liquor from self-service dispensing machines, subject to certain conditions.
