THE HEARING WILL THEN BE CLOSED AND THE MATTER DECIDED. THE CITY COUNCIL'S DECISION WILL BE DELINEATED IN ITS MOTION AND RENDERED IN WRITING BY WAY OF A DEVELOPMENT ORDER, RESOLUTION, OR ORDINANCE EVIDENCING ITS DECISION.
