WHEREAS, the State Legislature and the Governor enacted legislation that establishes a “property tax cap” on the amount that a local government’s property tax levy can increase each year, and

WHEREAS, under this law, the total amount to be raised through property taxes

charged on the municipality's taxable assessed value of property will be capped at two (2) per percent or the rate of inflation, whichever is less, with some exceptions, and

WHEREAS, state legislation provides for local governments to override the Cap to protect from unforeseen financial circumstances, and

WHEREAS, state legislation requires that in the event that an override is necessary, the law enabling it must already have been adopted by the Board of Trustees prior to the adoption of the fiscal year budget;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Pleasantville hereby authorizes the Village Clerk to Notice a Public Hearing for Monday, February 9, 2029 at 8:00pm to be held at Village Hall, 80 Wheeler Avenue, Pleasantville, New York to hear comments on Introductory Local Law 3 of 2026 Overriding the Property Tax Cap for Village Fiscal Year 2026-2027.

WHEREAS, Vision Zero is a strategy to eliminate traffic fatalities and serious injuries, while increasing safe, healthy, equitable mobility for all roadway users; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Pleasantville was awarded a U.S. Department of Transportation Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan for the Village; and

WHEREAS, the first component of a safety action plan requires leadership commitment and goal setting, that includes commitment by a high-ranking official and/or governing body to an eventual goal of zero roadway fatalities and serious injuries; and

WHEREAS, the Vision Zero strategy will include preparation of a comprehensive safety action plan to promote crash prevention to achieve the goal of zero fatalities and serious injuries in the Village of Pleasantville by 2045.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby sets the following Vision Zero Goal: The Village of Pleasantville's Vision Zero Goal is to reach zero fatal and serious injury roadway crashes by 2045.
