Ross Valley Paramedic Authority Amended and Restated Joint Powers Agreement. The Council’s discussion and approval of the Ross Valley Paramedic Authority Amended and Restated Joint Powers Agreement is not a “project” under the California Environmental Quality Act, because it does not involve an activity which has the potential to cause a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment. Receive and File the Resilience Hub Update. The proposed adoption of the resolution is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”), pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 “Existing Facilities” because the project consists of alterations to an existing Town-owned facility; CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) “Common Sense” exemption, because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant negative effect on the environment.
